- Minimum 3 years teaching holistic nursing (or commensurate experience)
- Content expert in holistic nursing
- Role model of active self-care practice
- Inspirational and energetic presence
- Available for unrestricted US travel: weekends and weekdays

## **Position Description**

### • Provide appropriate and effective instruction:

- Use only approved materials when teaching
- Provide learning activities that stimulate participant engagement, encourage reflection and critical thinking, and take into consideration different learning styles
- Provide learning activities that achieve identified Purpose, Goals and Learning
   Objectives for the program
- Oversee use of teaching facility while teaching educational session
- Teach course material
- Attend to participants during scheduled class time, break times, and meal times
- Provide information about available resources (if requested)
- Written/verbal responses to participants (as necessary)
- o Able to lift 25 lbs. (eg. boxed manuals, program materials) as requested
- Assist in annual revision of program content manual
